The Power of the Tongue

Rev. Matt Kuiken

James 3:1-12

Taming the Tongue

3 Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness. ² For we all stumble in many ways. And if anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle his whole body. ³ If we put bits into the mouths of horses so that they obey us, we guide their whole bodies as well. ⁴ Look at the ships also: though they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are guided by a very small rudder wherever the will of the pilot directs. ⁵ So also the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great things.

How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire! ⁶ And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by hell. ⁷ For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and sea creature, can be tamed and has been tamed by mankind, ⁸ but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. ⁹ With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. ¹⁰ From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers, these things ought not to be so. ¹¹ Does a spring pour forth from the same opening both fresh and salt water? ¹² Can a fig tree, my brothers, bear olives, or a grapevine produce figs? Neither can a salt pond yield fresh water.

Questions for Discussion:

- In Psalm 141:3 it says, “Set a guard over my mouth, O Lord; keep watch over the door of my lips.” What does this have to do with James 3:1-12?
- Which metaphor of the tongue does James use that most resonates with you, and why?
- Should a Christian be desirous of the role of teaching? Why or why not?
- What are some ways you can bless your family/friends or complete strangers this week with your words?


Pledge Sunday October 25, 2020

Over the next few weeks, our elders and deacons will be preparing a proposed 2021 Ministry Budget. Our greatest concern is that the proposed budget reflects God's will for our church and our vision to be a church with deep roots and a wide reach. The leadership covets your prayers for God's wisdom and leading throughout this process.

Traditionally our church has built our ministry budget based on congregational pledges as well as faith in God's continuing work. To assist us in preparing this budget and practicing good stewardship, we are asking you to prayerfully consider making a financial pledge for 2021. The giving of tithes (10% of your income) and offerings (gifts in addition to your tithe) to your church is a biblical responsibility, and faithfulness in this area often results in great spiritual blessing.

You should have received a letter in the mail with a pledge card enclosed (*see photo below*). Additional pledge cards are available in the pew racks.

Next Sunday, October 25th you will have an opportunity to offer your commitment to the Lord at both worship services. The final approval for the 2021 Ministry Budget will take place at a Congregational Meeting on December 6, 2020.
